ANNOUNCEMENT:

Circuit Motor Cycle Racing Test Day organised by NG Road Racing Club, held under the National Sporting Code and the Standing Regulations of the ACU, these Supplementary Regulations, plus any Final Instructions issued or Official Announcements made prior to or during the event.

FI IGIRII ITY:

Entries will only be accepted from competitors who hold valid current ACU or Scottish ACU Competition Licence for Road Racing. Entries will be accepted from other FIM Europe affiliated FMN's Licence holders subject to production of written start permission and proof of Insurance to at least FIM minimum standards. Licences **must** be produced when signing on.

ENTRIES:

The Club reserves the right to refuse entry, abandon, cancel or postpone the Meeting or alter the programme of events and or the timetable.

Entry fees: The entry fees are detailed on the Event Entry Form and online. Both online entries and paper entries are available for these events, card payments will be processed three weeks prior to the meeting. Manual online payments can be made once entry form has been emailed to Race Administration.

Cancellations & Refund Policy: If after payment has been taken, a rider has a genuine reason for not being able to attend the event, he/she must inform Race Administration in writing and any passes issued must be returned immediately. Once the passes are returned, a refund will be arranged less an administration charge of £50.00. If a rider cancels within 7 days of day 1 of the event i.e. the Friday test day, a 50% refund of all fees paid will be given. Withdrawal once the event has started: Should a rider experience a problem during a Friday test day, deeming him/her unable to continue participation at the event, a 50% refund of all fees paid for the Saturday and Sunday will be paid. It is essential you or a team member keep Race Administration fully informed of your situation at all times. Once Free Practice has commenced on Saturday morning, no refunds for the weekend will be given. NG Road Racing reserve the right to review refunds on a case-by-case basis.

Race Numbers: Numbers must always be displayed on machines while on track.

INSURANCE

The Organisers undertake to insure each rider and passenger, indemnifying them against any third party claims arising out of the races or official practice, excluding claims by other riders or passengers, entrant, sponsor, or mechanic, in accordance with the scheme of insurance set out in the current ACU Document Library at www.acu.org.uk

CHANGE OF MACHINE OR RIDER:

Either the rider/passenger or machine, but not both, may be changed on a request in writing to the Entries Secretary and not later than 09:30 on the day of the meeting.

TECHNICAL INSPECTION:

It is the rider's responsibility to ensure their machine is race worthy and prepared in accordance with the current ACU Standing Regulations for Road Race available within the ACU Document Library at www.acu.org.uk.

TYRES:

Except where stipulated in the class regulations or the ACU handbook the use of slick tyres is permitted.

RACE ADMINISTRATION:

Open from 07:00 Friday morning

PROGRAMME OF EVENTS:

4 groups. On track activities commence at 09:00hrs. Sessions end at 17:00hrs. There will be a 1-hour lunch break. At events where ACU Basic Rider Assessments are taking place, general testing may end at 4pm. See Final Instructions for further details.

NEW LICENCE HOLDERS:

All Novice/Intermediate Novice licence holders are required to always wear an orange jacket while on circuit.

TIMING and TRANSPONDERS:

There is no official timing provided at this event.

ADMISSION:

Off track, there is a strict speed limit of 20mph. Animals are NOT permitted at any time, except for registered and licensed "Service" dogs which will be admitted only at the express, prior written permission of NG Road Racing and the Circuit Owners Whilst we welcome children and families, for their own safety children must be supervised at all times and are prohibited from riding bicycles and scooters in the paddock whilst the race circuit is live.

COURSE CONDUCT:

Riders must only enter and leave the circuit at designated points. Riding of motorised paddock bikes is prohibited. Crash helmets must be worn at all times while riding. Dangerous riding or unsporting conduct will result in disqualification and / or a fine. Under 16-year-olds, unless a competitor, are not permitted in the pit lane. The "Fit-to-Ride" process remains in place as per NGRRC Race meetings and must be adhered to without exception. If you fall from your machine regardless of circumstances or speed, you must report to a Medical Officer and be declared fit-to-ride, and Race Control notified before rejoining the circuit.

By taking part in this meeting, you accept that photographs may be taken for promotional purposes and used on the NG Road Racing Club website or NG Road Racing Club promotional materials. NOISE TESTING: Machines will be noise tested prior to joining the circuit for testing.
